



## Basic Pest Management Training Requirement

According to the Healthy Schools Act of 2016, all persons using pesticides (defined as any chemical that kills living organisms, including bacteria) in a school or child care setting have to obtain a certificate in the safe handling and use of those products. As a working parent in our classroom, you will be expected to clean and disinfect on a regular basis and therefore will need to go through the training provided by the California Department of Pesticide Regulation and provide the school with a copy of your certificate of completion.

Follow the steps outlined below to complete the training and submit your certificate.

- Click on **Basic Course**, and set up a quick account (which will allow you to renew easily if you re-enroll at JMPNS in the future).
